- Session Blurb - an advertisement to get staff interested in attending your session – this will be printed in the training schedule guide so staff can read about their options. *60 word limit.*
- Session Description – tell us about your program – what do you want to do, what do you want staff to get out of your session, an outline/plan for your session – this just helps the Training committee know what your program is all about & will not be seen by general staff. *300 word limit.*
