The Housing Exemption process is for new, incoming first-year students who meet the requirements to be exempt from the first-year live-on requirement. First-year students less than 12 months from their high school graduation date are required to live on campus. If exempt for the fall semester for online courses, they will be required to live on campus for the spring term unless they are also online at that time.

The Housing Exemption process for Spring 2021 closed on January 26. Enrolled students may no longer be released from the Residence Hall License Contract for spring.

The Housing Exemption process is not currently available for Continuing students for Fall 2021 since continuing students are not required to live on campus.
